
Whereas, the discharge of firearms and air guns in lots 10 acres or smaller threatens the health and safety of the citizens of Bandera County, Texas.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Bandera County Commissioners Court enters an order as attached hereto as Exhibit "A" prohibiting the discharge of firearms and air guns on certain lots in a subdivision in Bandera County, Texas and replacing any and all prior orders of the Bandera County Commissioners Court relating to the discharge of firearms.



ORDER REGARDING THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS AND
AIR GUNS IN CERTAIN AREAS OF

THEREFORE, it is further ordered that any person who violates a provision of this Section shall be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor.



THEREFORE, it is further ordered that any person who violates a provision of this Section shall be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor.




